Newark and Sherwood Concert Band is a symphonic wind band based in Newark, Nottinghamshire. It was formed in 1998 and currently has a membership of approximately 50 musicians. Standards vary but all musicians are of at least Grade 5 standard with a number who are professional/diploma graduates. There is no requirement to audition to join.

Although mainly an adult band, talented youngsters have always been welcome (current ages range from 8 to 80). It rehearses weekly on Tuesday evenings between 19:00 and 21:30 and from early May 2015, rehearsals will take place at Kelham Hall & Country Park, Main Road, Kelham, Newark, Nottinghamshire.

The band has performed at events and venues all over Nottinghamshire and surrounding counties and there are already 11 concerts in the calendar for 2015. The band's repertoire is large and varied, and includes film themes, musicals, traditional military marches, classical pieces and more contemporary jazz and swing tunes.
